- PTO will have pizza and drinks for sale! Please bring small bills if you are planning to buy.
- Prizes will be awarded to the top three trunks vote getters.
- We will have a DJ playing spooky tunes.
- In case of inclement weather, there is no rain date. Final weather decision (if the weather is iffy) will be made by 10 a.m. on the 2nd via posts on email, PTO website, Twitter & Facebook.
- No dogs or alcohol. All kids must have an adult with them that is responsible for them during the event.
